



## Isiah Davenport House Museum

This Federal-style home was completed by master-builder, Isiah Davenport as his family residence in 1820. Authentically restored, the house museum features original plasterwork, a cantilever staircase and period furnishings true to the 1820s.

The Davenport House is open to the public for docent-led tours Monday-Saturday 10am-4pm, and Sunday 1-4pm.

# Historic Savannah Foundation

Historic Savannah Foundation (HSF) is a non-profit historic preservation organization supported by a dedicated membership. The mission of Historic Savannah Foundation (HSF) is to preserve and protect Savannah's heritage through advocacy, education and community involvement. HSF was established in 1955 to save the 1820 Isiah Davenport House from demolition. From this initial project, we launched a Revolving Fund that has helped save more than 350 buildings and counting. HSF has a staff of seven and a variety of outreach programs that support our mission and educate the public about the benefits of historic preservation.

## Advocacy

Representing a diverse and passionate constituency, HSF is the voice for preservation in Savannah and Chatham County. HSF steps up and speaks out on issues that concern Savannah and Chatham County's historic districts. Through our Architectural Review Committee (ARC), and contact with Historic Neighborhood Councils, we help establish strong positions on current issues that impact all of Savannah's historic districts. The ARC serves as a conduit between HSF's members and the Historic District Board of Review (HDBR). HSF regularly attends HDBR and Metropolitan Planning Commission (MPC) meetings, City Council meetings, etc. to ensure that a preservation perspective is considered when decisions are being made that impact historic neighborhoods.

## Education

Throughout the year, HSF engages in various educational programs. Our lecture series invites both members and the general public to learn about preservation issues and topics. Hands on History Camp gives rising freshman in the Savannah-Chatham County Public School System (SCCPSS) a hands-on exploration of the field of historic preservation. Also, HSF helps SCCPSS students learn about architecture, planning and community development through a nationally recognized program called Box City.

## Community Involvement

Started in 1959, HSF's Revolving Fund is nationally recognized for saving more than 350 historic buildings. HSF raises money to purchase endangered historic resources, stabilizes and secures them, attaches protective covenants, then sells them to sensitive buyers. Any proceeds are put back into the Fund and are recycled to save other endangered historic buildings.
