

HISTORIC SAVANNAH FOUNDATION 2012 PRESERVATION AWARDS

Each year, Historic Savannah Foundation (HSF) celebrates the best of preservation by presenting Preservation Awards to individuals and organizations whose contributions demonstrate excellence in historic preservation. HSF invites you to participate by nominating individuals and organizations you believe are most deserving of these honors. The award winners will be announced at HSF's Preservation Awards Luncheon on May 10, 2012.

AWARD CATEGORIES

RESTORATION - Awarded for or to restoration projects that allow for the depiction of a building at a particular time in its history by preserving materials from the period of significance and removing material from other periods.

REHABILITATION - Awarded for or to rehabilitation projects that acknowledge the need to alter or add to a historic property to meet continuing or new uses while retaining the building's historic character. Adaptive use would fall under this category.

NEW CONSTRUCTION - Awarded for or to new construction projects that are visually compatible in height, mass, scale and materials with the surrounding historic buildings within the immediate context.

STEWARDSHIP - Awarded to an individual or organization which has consistently and carefully maintained and enhanced a historic site or monument in Savannah or Chatham County.

CRAFTSMANSHIP - Awarded to an individual who has mastered a building arts trade that has enhanced the practice of preservation in Savannah or Chatham County.

ARCHEOLOGY - Awarded to an individual or organization who follows the Secretary of the Interior's standards for Archeology on major projects in Savannah and the surrounding historic areas.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Winning projects will have followed the applicable Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Preserving, Rehabilitating, Restoring or Reconstructing historic buildings. For more information on this visit <http://www.nps.gov/history/hps/tps/standguide/>.

Historic Savannah Foundation Preservation Awards are judged for the success they have achieved in the preservation, rehabilitation, restoration, and interpretation of our architectural and cultural heritage. The general evaluation criteria include:

1. Quality and degree of difficulty of the nominee's project or effort.
2. Degree to which the nominee's project or effort is unusual or pioneering, or serves as an example that influences good preservation practices in others.
3. Demonstrable impact of nominee's project or effort on the community.

A jury of local professionals is invited each year to review nominations for HSF's Preservation Awards. Although the composition of the jury changes from year to year, Historic Savannah Foundation strives to achieve balanced representation from the related disciplines of architecture, preservation and planning.

ELIGIBILITY

- Nominated projects must have been completed within the past three years.
- Nominations submitted in previous years that were not selected to receive an award may be revised, expanded, and resubmitted. Nominations may be made without the knowledge of the nominee. Self-nominations will be accepted.
- Historic Savannah Foundation projects, Trustees, and staff are not eligible to receive a Preservation Award for individual achievement during the period of their active service and for three years thereafter.
- Nominations are open only to Historic Savannah Foundation members. If you are currently a member of HSF please fill out the name that the membership is listed under on the reverse side of this form where indicated.

In addition to this application form please submit the following:

\$20 non-refundable nomination fee (Please make checks payable to Historic Savannah Foundation).

A concise summary (750 words or less) explaining the project, work completed, why the project is noteworthy, including challenges overcome, unique strategies and activities carried out, impact that this project has had on the community or immediate neighborhood, and a BRIEF architectural or historical significance of the structure. **Please submit as a Microsoft Word file on a disk.**

Five "before" and five "after" color images portraying the project submitted on a disk. Only **JPEG** files will be accepted, preferably at a resolution of 250 dpi or greater. All images should be clearly titled in the file name by address/name and designated as "before" or "after." Ideally, "after" images should directly relate to "before" images. All images should include a credit line for publication, if applicable. Submissions will not be returned.

Supporting brochures, news clippings, letters of support and listing of any awards received will be accepted, if applicable.

Include contact information (name, address and phone number) for Owner, Architect, Contractor and other project partners, if applicable.

Nominations are open only to Historic Savannah Foundation members. If you are currently a member of HSF please list the name that the membership is under:
